Hindu Nadar - 3 (Three)

(This unit include Palakkad, Malappuram, Kozhikode, Kannur, Wayanad and Kasaragod Districts).

- Note:- (i) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the Communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued.
- (ii) Separate Ranked list will be prepared for Kannur Unit in pursuance of this notification. Ranked list thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following district.

- (iii) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a Unit basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(Ms) No.92/80/Home dated 24.09.1980. A candidate advised for appointment in one Unit from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another unit. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O.(MS) No.4/61/PD, dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one unit are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.
- (iv) The recruitment of Male warder in the Jail Department is being done on Unitwise, a candidate thus appointed in Kannur unit is bound to serve in any of the institutions under the Jurisdiction of Kannur unit which includes Palakkad, Malappuram, Kozhikode, Kannur, Wayanad and Kasaragod district.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (from candidates belonging to Hindu Nadar communities only).
6. Age : 18-38; (Including the relaxation as per para 2(i) of the General Conditions) Only candidates born between 2.1.1973 and 1.1.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

Note:- For conditions regarding other age relaxation please see para 2 of the general conditions except 2(i). For concessions allowed in upper age limit, the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years.

7. Qualifications:

1) Pass in SSLC or its equivalent qualification.

2) Physical fitness as specified below:-

(a) Must be at least 165 cm height and

(b) Must be 81.3 cms round the chest on full expiration and must have chest expansion of at least 5 cms.

- 3) Other qualifications being equal, the Home guard volunteers who have completed the term of 3 years in that organization and who have undergone training during the period of tenure satisfactorily, will be treated as having additional or desirable qualification.
- 4) **Eye Sight:-** Must be certified to possess the Visual standards specified below without glasses (Medical Certificate from a Medical Officer not below the Rank of an Assistant Surgeon should be produced when called for).

	<u>Right Eye</u>	<u>Left Eye</u>
a) Distant Vision	6/6 Snellen	6/6 Snellen
b) Near Vision	0.5 Snellen	0.5 Snellen
c) Each Eye must have full field of vision. Colour blindness, squint or any other morbid condition of the eyes or lids of either eye will be deemed to be a disqualification.		

- 5) Proficiency in Sports, Military Training and Membership in National Cadet Corps will be considered as additional qualification.

6) **Physical Efficiency Test:**

Candidates will be subjected to a Physical Efficiency Test and must qualify themselves in the following events namely,

- a) 100 Metres Run : 14 seconds
- b) High Jump OR : 132.20 Cms (4 feet 6 inches)
- Long Jump : 457.20 Cms (15 feet)
- c) Rope Climbing (by using Hands only) : 365.80 Cms (12 feet)

Note:- Physically handicapped candidates and women are not eligible to apply for the Post.

8. Mode of submitting applications:-

The applications with Photo uploaded shall be submitted online only to the website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The candidates applying on-line shall keep the print out (Receipt) of their applications and the bar code number shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualifications, age, community etc. have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

9. Last date of receipt of applications: 14/12/2011 Wednesday upto 12 midnight

10. Address to which applications are to be sent : www.keralapsc.org.

11. If a written test/OMR test is conducted as a part of the selection, hall ticket of eligible candidates will be made available in the website of Kerala Public Service commission. Candidates are instructed to download their hall tickets as per the instructions given in the website.

12. At the time of examination , Interview etc candidates shall produce their photo affixed ID proof in original (Voter's Identity card, Driving Licence, Passport, Identity card issued by social welfare Department to PH candidates, photo affixed passbook issued by Nationalised Banks, PAN card, Identity card issued to Govt. employees by the concerned Departments) and its self attested photocopy along with the hall tickets.
